

Feeding the Hungry

We are grateful to the many, many volunteers who made our Lenten Fish Fry another great success! We donate 10% of the net proceeds to the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank. Each year 33 million meals are distributed and 8 million pounds of healthy produce provided through the Food Bank. The gross income for the Fish Fry was **\$122,157.47**. Total expenses were **\$60,677.81**. The net profit was **\$61,475.66**. Our donation to the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank is **\$6,147.57!** Our donation will be doubled by a group of generous Food Bank supporters who will match all gifts dollar for dollar when received by the end of April! Our gift then becomes **\$12,295.14!** That amount will provide 1,918 nutritious meals for children in the summer meals program. Thank you for your generous support and hours of volunteering to make this possible! Jesus multiplied the bread and the fish for the hungry crowds listening to his words. The miracle continues!
